*Scholarships are offered to study for:*

## **Master's**

- Economic Theory
- Public Policy

## **Doctorado**

- Economics

(\*)For the Master's in Administrative and Regulatory Law, those accepted initially must attend two pre-registration refresher courses with a duration of 2 months, which begin in November of 2009, while the Master's Program proper begins in January 2010.

(\*\*) *For the Doctorate in Economics, scholarships can be granted for pursuing the full program or for a period of one or two semesters for candidates currently studying as from the second year of equivalent doctoral programs. Candidates applying for one or two semesters must have met all the requirements of the first year of the equivalent Doctorate, including basic courses of microeconomics, macroeconomics and econometrics.*

## **Eligibility**

Scholarships are offered to nationals of the countries in which the Call for SRE Scholarships for Foreigners is distributed.

## **Duration:**

Master's: eighteen months to two years

Doctorate: three years

## **Requirements**

- Complete all requirements of the Call for SRE Scholarships for Foreigners.
- Grade point average of 9, on a scale of 1 to 10, or its equivalent.
- A minimum grade of 90% in the admissions exam. In the case of the Master's in Economic Theory, a minimum score of 740 in the quantitative section of the general Graduate Record Examination.
- Essays and letters of recommendation required by each of the Master's or Ph.D. programs.

- Completing the admission process and obtaining a letter of acceptance from ITAM.
- *Those interested in studying one or two semesters in ITAM must have met all corresponding requirements of the first year of the Doctorate with a minimum grade of 9, in a 1 to 10 scale, and must submit a letter of recommendation from their university.*
- Recipients of the scholarship must return to their country upon completion of the graduate program for which they were awarded the scholarship.
- Submit candidature on Application Form A, included in this Call.
